| Shallot | ☆Zebrune (Banana) | 100: Gourmet sweet/mild banana type. Pinkish brown skin, distinctive torpedo shape |
| Shallot | ☆Conservor FI Hybrid | 110: Round, reddish-brown single-bulb shallots with excellent storage capacity |
| Leek | ☆Large American Flag | 120: Heirloom leek with compact habit and mild flavor; a must for soups! |
| Scallion | ☆Italian Scallion | 65: Full-flavored baby salad onions. Use young as scallions or allow 1/2"-1" bulbs to form |
| Onion | ☆Assorted Fun Pack | a joyful mix of shapes, colors and flavors of open-pollinated varieties of onions |
| Onion | ☆Walla Walla | 110: Int. day. Very mild, sweet white flesh with brown skin. Up to 6", disease resistant. |
| Onion | ☆New York Early | 98: Classic round yellow onion, productive, early. Medium-large, stores 3-4 mos. |
| Onion | ☆Piatta Di Bergamo yellow cipollini | 110: Int.-Long day. Smallish, very flat, pinkish-brown cipollini type. Seed from Italy. |
| Onion | ☆Red Geneva | 105: Long day. Red cipollini (flat bulb) type with excellent flavor. Stores 4-5 mos. |
| Onion | ☆Long of Florence, Lungo di Firenze | 100: Int.-Long day. Mild, sweet, 4" long, narrow (torpedo-shaped), red onion. Stunning! |
| Onion | ☆Red Ronda Tropea | 100: Int.-Long day. Italian heirloom variety. Round, pinkish-red skin, sweet white flesh. |
| Onion | ☆Gladstone | 110: Int. day. Medium to large bulbs of mildly sweet white flesh, up to 5".. Moderate storage. |
| Celery | Utah 52-70 | 100: Disease-resistant, 12" tender, crisp stalks with classic celery flavor, sold in a 4 pack |
| Celery | Chinese Pink | 90: Easiest type of celery to grow! Lightly sweet, stunning neon pink stalks, sold in a 4 pack |
| Cutting Celery | ☆Cutting Celery | 60-90: Thin bright green stalks/leaves, distinct celery aroma, concentrated flavor |
| Celeriac | Brilliant | 100: Large, uniform roots with smooth interiors; 2 wks earlier than Prague! Sold in a 4 pack |
| Florence Fennel | Mantovano | 75-85: One of the largest & earliest fennels. Large, sweet, very white bulb. Sold in a 4 pack |
| French Sorrel | ☆Large Leaf | Perennial potherb; great for soups, salads, & smoothies. Very tart, lemony taste! |





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| Artichoke | ☆Imperial Star | 85: Produces well-developed green artichokes 1st yr. Treat as annual or mulch heavily. |
| Artichoke | ☆Colorado Star | 75: Produces numerous round purple (sometimes green/purple) chokes. High yields! |
| Cucumber | Armenian | 50-75: Light green, long slender ribbed fruit. Never bitter. |
| Cucumber | Richmond Green Apple | 70: Mottled & striped lime green, 3" oval fruit; sweet & crispy. Prolific. |
| Cucumber | Northern Pickling | 45-50: Short vines. 3-5" cukes good fresh & for pickling. Good container variety! |
| Cucumber | Boston Pickling | 65: Vigorous vines produce loads of crisp 4-5" cukes, as good for salad as for pickling. |
| Cucumber | Japanese Climbing | 58-65: Tender, crisp 9" long fruits. Good for trellising. Not bitter. |
| Cucumber | Marketmore | 58-70: 8" long, dark green fruits, dependable, disease resistant. |
| Cucumber | English Telegraph Improved | 60: 18' long, smooth, straight, dark green fruits. Crisp, tender, high-yielding. |
| Cucumber | Double Yield | 65: Smooth, sweet 6-9" cuke; not bitter or tough at any stage! Vigorous. |
| Eggplant | Florida High Bush (Black Beauty-type) | 80: Better than Black Beauty! Disease-resistant, prolific, huge deep purple fruits |
| Eggplant | Casper | 70: Pure white; 6" x 2" fruits; flavorful, mild flesh; compact plant |
| Eggplant | Listada di Gandia | 90: 7" long Spanish heirloom; white fruit w/ purple stripes. Tender & delicious. |
| Eggplant | Pingtung Long | 65-75: Dark lavender; tender/sweet; slender & up to 18" long |
| Eggplant | Patio Baby F1 Hybrid | 50: Great container variety! Many 3" fruits on compact plant. Spineless. |
| Eggplant | Rosa Bianca | 75: Bulbous & lightly lobed, rosy lavender w/ cream shading; not bitter |
| Eggplant | Thai Long Green | 70-80: Mild eggplant w/ apple green color, tender, 12" long; a staff favorite! |
| Melon | Charentais | 85: 2-3 lb. smooth grey-green skin, salmon-orange flesh; sweet, very fragrant |
| Melon | Emerald Gem | 70-90: Green, striped skin w/ exquisitely flavorful, pale orange flesh; 2-3lbs |
| Cantaloupe | Hales Best Jumbo | 85: Full-sized, fine-textured, delicious, bright orange flesh. Drought tolerant. |
| Cantaloupe | Minnesota Midget | 70-100: Early maturing, compact plant; 3 - 4" fruits; good in pots |
| Watermelon | Small Shining Light | 80-90: Early, 10-12" round, sweet red flesh, well-suited to high altitudes. |
| Watermelon | Sugar Baby Watermelon | 75: Early producing, very sweet, 8" round, 8 lb icebox melon. Drought-resistant |
| Okra | Burgundy | 55: Very tender and delicious, stunning magenta pods up to 8" long |
| Okra | Clemson Spineless | 55-60: Spineless plants; tasty 3" green pods |
| Hot Pepper | Aji Crystal (50,000 Scoville) | 90: spicy citrus flavor best when immature; great for salsa. HOT |

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| Hot Pepper | NuMex Joe E. Parker Anaheim (4,500 Scoville) | 70-95: Versatile 8" tapered peppers. Green ripens to red. Prolific. MED HOT |
| Hot Pepper | Ancho Grande (Poblano) (2,000 Scoville) | 76: 4" medium hot; called poblano when green. MEDIUM |
| Hot Pepper | Beaver Dam (1,000 Scoville) | 80: Mildly hot large peppers ripen lime-green to red. MEDIUM |
| Hot Pepper | Black Hungarian (2,500 Scoville) | 75: Mildly hot, black jalapeno-shaped fruit (rare). MILD HEAT |
| Hot Pepper | Cayenne Long Red Narrow | 70: 5" long, thin; very hot, great for drying, processing, or sauce. HOT |
| Hot Pepper | Fish (30,000 Scoville) | 80: 3" medium hot, variegated, versatile. Ark of Taste! MED HOT |
| Hot Pepper | Habanero (Orange) (350,000 Scoville) | 90: Incredibly hot, small, golden-orange fruits. HOT |
| Hot Pepper | Jalapeno Tam (1,500 Scoville) | 70: All the flavor but less heat than standard jalapeños. MEDIUM. |
| Hot Pepper | Early Jalapeno (10,000) | 65: Hot, classic jalapeno but produces fruit earlier. HOT |
| Hot Pepper | Craig's Grande Jalapeno (10,000) | 80: Thick, flavorful hot flesh, classic jalapeno flavor, great for salsa. HOT |
| Hot Pepper | Hungarian Hot Wax (10,000 Scoville) | 83: Yellow, tapered, 5" long; productive; sought-after variety! HOT |
| Hot Pepper | Santa Fe Grande (700 Scoville) | 75-80: Medium-thick walls, yellow-orange. HOT |
| Hot Pepper | Serrano Tampequino (5,000 Scoville) | 80: 2" slender fruits ripen to red, prolific. HOT |
| Hot Pepper | Thai Hot Chili | 80: SHU up to 100,000. Abundance of 1" blazing red, very hot peppers. |
| Death Pepper | ☆Carolina Reaper | 100+: SHU up to 2,200,000. Sweet & fruity; hottest pepper on record. |
| Death Pepper | ☆Trinidad Moruga Scorpion | 110: SHU up to 2,009,000. Fruity, flavorful, hottest until 2012. |
| Death Pepper | ☆Ghost (Bhut Jolokia) | 100+: SHU up to 1,041,000. Bitter heat, hottest until 2006. |
| Death Pepper | ☆Scotch Bonnet | 100+: SHU up to 350,000. Pineapple-like fruitiness, sweet, prolific. |
| Death Pepper | ☆Dragon's Breath | 100+: SHU 2,000,000+. Pure fire. Unofficially the world's hottest pepper. |
| Death Pepper | ☆Death Spiral | 100+: SHU up to 1,300,000. Fruity flavor with citrus notes. Quick burn. |
| Sweet Pepper | Alma Paprika (1,500 SHU) | 70-80: Productive; sweet, cherry-type; creamy white turns yellow then red |
| Sweet Pepper | Aji Cachucha Purple Splotched | 80: 3-4' tall plants loaded with unique, sweet, 2" fluted peppers. Caribbean variety. |
| Sweet Pepper | Biquinho (aka Little Beak) | 55(green)-75(red): aka "Little Beak." Brazilian, highly flavorful. Great pickled or fresh. |
| Sweet Pepper | Orange Picnic | 60 (green)-82 (orange): Sweet/tart, thick-walled, crunchy, adorable 3-5" orange bells |
| Sweet Pepper | Corno di Toro Rosso | 75-85: 8" long tapered red peppers; sweet and spicy |



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| Sweet Pepper | Jimmy Nardello | 80-90: 10" glossy red fruits; delicious for frying; productive; a favorite |
| Sweet Pepper | King of the North | 60 (green)-72 (red): Reliably heavy producer of thick-walled green bells; will ripen to red. |

| Sweet Pepper | Tolli's Sweet Italian | 75: Highly productive; 5" long cone-shaped red fruits; crunchy & sweet! |
| Pumpkin | Galeux d'Eysines | 100: French heirloom, 10-15 lb round pumpkin covered w/ warts. Prized flavor. |
| Pumpkin | Queensland Blue | 110: Blue turban-shaped 10-20 lb. fruit; deeply ribbed; gold flesh; sweet |
| Pumpkin | Baby Pam Pumpkin | 85: 7-10", Sweet, fine-grained flesh, perfect for pies, stores well |
| Pumpkin | Winter Luxury Pie Pumpkin | 105: Taste test winner, 6 lb, rind covered in fine, white veil |
| Summer Squash | Black Beauty Zucchini | 50: Classic, versatile dark green zucchini squash. Compact bush plants. |
| Summer Squash | Bennings Green Tint Pattypan | 57: Scalloped light green squash; sweet/tender, less susceptible to squash bugs |
| Summer Squash | Lemon | 55: Lemon yellow fruit, compact but prolific; resistant to squash bugs |
| Summer Squash | Costata Romanesco | 52: Clearly superior texture & flavor to other zucchini. Striped and ribbed. |
| Winter Squash | Buttercup - Burgess | 95: Turban shaped; dark green; orange flesh tastes like sweet potatoes |
| Winter Squash | Butternut Honey Nut | 110: Sweet, single serving size, compact vines, powdery mildew resistant |
| Winter Squash | Waltham Butternut | 100: Customer favorite! Sweet orange flesh, stores well |
| Winter Squash | Bush Delicata | 80: Smooth, nutty flesh; Compact bush habit; Powdery mildew resistant |
| Winter Squash | Spaghetti Squash | 88: Yellow with tasty stringy flesh like spaghetti; delicious roasted |
| Winter Squash | Table Queen Acorn Squash | 80: Dark green 1.5 lb fruits with orange flesh; classic |
| Ground Cherry | Aunt Molly's Ground Cherry | 65-70: Sweet & fruity; golden orange; great for fresh-eating; long storing |

| Potato | ☆ Rose Finn Apple | Mid/late season fingerling. Rose-blushed beige skin and deep yellow flesh. Exquisite flavor and cooking qualities make this a gourmet delight. Tubers set near surface so hill up well to prevent greening. |
| Potato | ☆ Yukon Gold | Early season. All-purpose, very dependable variety with finely flaked buff skin and rich yellow flesh. Extremely popular and an excellent storage potato. |
