Position description:	Minor repairs to planting boxes, sheds, pergolas and other Wasatch Community Gardens infrastructure at locations across the Salt Lake Valley. Responsibilities could include irrigation repairs, light carpentry, roofing repairs, painting, staining, electrical and plumbing fixes.
Ideal volunteer:	This is the perfect volunteer opportunity for someone who is very handy, quickly understands the scope of a project and can see it through to completion with minimal supervision. Having your own transport, basic tools and self-reliance will be key.

Dates needed:	Availability during the working week is most helpful.
Location of volunteer work:	At any and various WGC sites.
requirements:	18 years old Must maintain a volunteer log sheet Volunteer should watch the weather report to determine appropriate clothing. It is recommended that s/he wear layers, closed-toe shoes, hat, sunscreen. Volunteer should also bring water & refillable water bottle, and food/snacks.
qualifications:	Demonstrable “handy” skills.
training provided:	A full briefing will be provided, identifying the scope of the project, but no training will be given for the skills required to complete it.
