| Crop | Variety | Tag Description |
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| Swiss Chard | Peppermint** | Stalks are white w/ vivid pink striping. Glossy, dark green savoyed leaves. Bolt resistant. 4-pack of starts |
| Swiss Chard | Rainbow OG WCG** | Striking stalks in neon red, pink, orange, yellow & white. Seed grown by WCG. 4 pack of starts |
| Swiss Chard | Ruby Red OG** | aka Rhubarb Chard. Lovely red stalks with forest green lightly crumpled leaves. 4 pack of starts |
| Swiss Chard | Orange OG ** | Vivid tangerine-colored stems make this as ornamental as it is delicious! 4 pack of starts |
| Kale | Black Tuscan OG ** | Aka Lacinato or Dinosaur kale. Blue-green crinkly foliage. Dates to 1700s. 4 pack of starts |
| Kale | Rainbow Lacinato OG ** | Bolt resistant. Purplish red stems and curly leaf edges. Stunning! 4 pack of starts |
| Kale | Dwarf Blue Scotch Curled OG ** | Dense, frilly, finely-curved blue green leaves. Most commonly grown variety of kale. 4 pack of starts |
| Collards | Champion OG ** | Long, broad, tender, wavy leaves. Plant can reach 4' high and 3' across. 4 pack of starts |
| Lettuce | Pirat OG WCG ** | Heat-tolerant butterhead. Huge, tender heads w/ red-tinged outer leaves. 4 pack of starts |
| Shallot | Banana: Creme Brulee F1 (BGS-270) ** | 105: Gourmet sweet/mild banana type. Peachy-pink skin, distinctive shape 4 pack of starts |
| Shallot | Conservor F1 OG ** | 110: Round, reddish-brown single-bulb shallots with excellent storage capacity |
| Leek | King Richard OG ** | 75: Early leek ready by late August. Upright shanks up to 1' long. Delicious! |
| Scallion | Italian Scallion ** | 65: Baby red salad onions. Use young as scallions or allow 1/2"-1" bulbs to form |
| Onion | Assorted Fun Pack ** | A joyful mix of shapes, colors and flavors of onions, each one a surprise! |
| Onion | Walla Walla Sweet Spanish ** | 110: Int. day. Very mild, sweet white flesh w/ brown skin. Disease resistant. |
| Onion - Cipollini | Red Geneva OG ** | 105: Long day. Red cipollini (flat bulb) type; excellent flavor. Stores 4-5 mos. |
| Onion | New York Early OG ** | 98: Long day. Round, yellow, med-lg, & early. Classic. Stores 3-4 mos. |
| Onion | Dakota Tears OG ** | 112: Long day, 1 lb. very hard yellow bulbs. Robust flavor. Stores 6+ mos. |
| Onion | Blush F1** | 100: Long day, 3-4" brown to pink champagne color, stores 4-6 mos. Hybrid. |

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| Onion | Long of Florence ** | 100: Int.-Long day. Mild, sweet, 4" long, torpedo-shaped, red onion. Stunning! |
| Onion | Rossa di Milano OG ** | 100: Long day. Bronze-pink onion, stores 6+ months. Resistant to onion thrips! |
| Celery | Utah 52-70 OG ** | 100: Disease-resistant, 12" tender, crisp stalks with classic celery flavor. Comes in a 4 pack of starts |
| Celery | Pink Plume OG ** | 90: Thin, solid stalks are blushed w/ purple. Sweet w/ intense flavor. Comes in a 4 pack of starts. |
| Cutting Celery | Cutting Celery OG** | 60-90: Thin, hollow, bright green stalks/leaves, strong celery aroma, concentrated flavor |
| Celeriac | Monstropolgi OG ** | 100: Large, uniform roots w/ smooth interiors; 2 wks earlier than other types. Comes in a 4 pack of starts |
| Artichoke | Tavor OG ** | 84: Get well-developed green artichokes 1st yr. Improved Imperial Star type. |
| Artichoke | Colorado Star ** | 75: Produces numerous round purple (sometimes green/purple) chokes. |
| Cardoon | Porto Spineless ** | 100:Tender perennial w/ edible leaf stalks & midribs, flavored like artichoke. |
| Gourd | Luffa OG ** | 100: Aka Sponge Gourd. Edible when young but used for "scrubber" once mature/dried. |
| Sweet Pepper | Alma Paprika OG | 70-80: Productive; sweet, cherry-type; creamy white turns yellow then red (1,500 Scoville) |
| Sweet Pepper | Biquinho (red) | 55 grn /75 red: "Little Beaks" are 1/2-1" & have slight heat. Eat fresh or pickle! (500-1,000 Scoville) |
| Sweet Pepper | Orange Picnic OG | 60 grn -82 orange: Super sweet, thick-walled, crunchy, adorable 3-5" bells |
| Sweet Pepper | Corno di Toro Rosso OG | 75-85: up to 8" long, tapered red peppers; sweet and spicy |
| Sweet Pepper | Jimmy Nardello OG | 80-90: 10" glossy red fruits; delicious for frying; productive. Ark of Taste variety |
| Sweet Pepper | King of the North | 60 (green)-72 (red): Reliably heavy producer of thick-walled green bells; ripens to red |
| Sweet Pepper | Garden Sunshine | 80-100: 8" bells start creamy yellow then turn orange then red. Best flavor when red! |
| Sweet Pepper | Purple Beauty OG | 74: Blocky 3x3" peppers ripen from purple to deep purple/red. Sweet, tender & crisp! |
| Sweet Pepper | Quadrato D'asti Giallo OG | 80: Giant yellow bell; thick walls; sweet & rich; high-yielding |
| Sweet Pepper | Shishito | 60: Green, 3" long, gourmet Japanese pepper for roasting, frying & grilling. (500 Scoville) |
| Sweet Pepper | Tolli's Sweet Italian OG | 75: Highly productive; 5" long cone-shaped red fruits; crunchy & sweet! |
| Hot Pepper | Aji Pineapple | 90: Peruvian variety, delicious fruity tones. Less hot than Aji Crystal. HOT (20,000 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Anaheim OG | 80: Popular 8" long green peppers ripen to red; prolific. MILD HEAT (2,000 – 3,200 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Ancho Poblano OG | 76: 4" medium hot; called poblano when green. MEDIUM (2,000 Scoville) |

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| Hot Pepper | Beaver Dam OG | 80: Mildly hot large peppers ripen lime-green to red. MEDIUM (1,000 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Black Hungarian OG | 75: Mildly hot, blackish-green, jalapeno-shaped fruit. MILD HEAT (2,500 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Cayenne Red Rocket OG | 55 green, 75 red: 5" long, thin; very hot, great for drying or sauce. HOT (8,000-22,000 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Fish OG | 80: 3" medium hot, variegated, versatile. Ark of Taste variety. MED HOT (30,000 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Habanero: Magnum (Orange) OG | 80 green/100 orange: Uniform, shiny, small orange fruits on tall plants. HOT (210,000 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Jalapeno Tam (1,500 to 3,000 Scoville) | 70: All the flavor but less heat than standard jalapeños. MILD-MEDIUM (1,500 – 3,000 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Jalapeno Early OG (10,000 Scoville) | 65: Hot, classic jalapeno but produces fruit earlier. HOT (10,000 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Jalapeno Traveler | 70 green/90 red: Thick, flavorful, classic flavor, great for salsa. 3" long. HOT (10,000-12,000 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Hungarian Hot Wax OG | 83: Yellow, tapered, 5" long; productive; sought-after variety! HOT (10,000 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Santa Fe Grande | 75-80: Medium-thick walls, yellow-orange. MILD HEAT (700 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Serrano Tampequino | 80: 2" slender fruits ripen to red, prolific. MEDIUM (5,000 Scoville) |
| Hot Pepper | Thai Hot Chili OG (25,000-40,000 Scoville) | 80: Abundance of 1" blazing red, very hot, conical-shaped peppers. HOT (25,000-40,000 Scoville) |
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| Death Pepper | Carolina Reaper (1.4-2.2 million)** | 100+: Sweet & fruity; hottest pepper on record. Up to 2,200,000 Scoville |
| Death Pepper | Trinidad Moruga Scorpion ** | 110: SHU up to 2,009,000. Fruity, flavorful, hottest until 2012. Up to 2,009,000 Scoville |
| Death Pepper | Scotch Bonnet ** | 100+: SHU up to 350,000. Pineapple-like fruitness, sweet, prolific. Up to 350,000 Scoville |
| Death Pepper | Dragon's Breath ** | 100+: Pure fire. Unofficially the world's hottest pepper. 2,000,000+ Scoville |
| Death Pepper | Death Spiral ** | 100+: Fruity flavor with citrus notes. Quick burn. Up to 1,300,000 Scoville |
| Death Pepper | Genghis Khan's Brain ** | 90+: Nice, fruity tones with intense heat. Up to 1,500,000 Scoville |
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| Cucumber | Armenian OG | 50-75: Light green, long, slender. ribbed fruit. Never bitter. |
| Cucumber | Salt & Pepper Pickler OG | 49: 3-5" creamy white-skinned pickler; powdery mildew resistant |
| Cucumber | National Pickling OG | 52: Vigorous vines produce loads of crisp 4-5" cukes for salad & pickling. |
| Cucumber | Japanese Climbing OG | 58-65: Tender, crisp 9" long fruits. Good for trellising. Not bitter. |
| Cucumber | Marketmore OG | 58-70: 8" long, dark green fruits, dependable, disease resistant. |
| Cucumber | Telegraph Improved | 60: 18" long, smooth, straight, dark green fruits. Crisp, tender, high-yielding. |
| Cucumber | Painted Serpent (Striped Armenian) OG | 55: aka Snake Melon. Native to Armenia. Exceptional flavor, best at 8-18" |
| Cucumber | Double Yield OG | 65: Smooth, sweet 6-9" cuke; not bitter or tough at any stage! Vigorous. |
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| Cucamelon | Mexican Sour Gherkin or Mouse Melon | 65: Delicate, scrambling 10' vines w/ loads of 1" crunchy, citrusy fruits. |
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| Eggplant | Florida High Bush (Black Beauty-type) | 80: Disease-resistant, prolific. Huge, deep black/purple fruits |

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| Eggplant | Casper | 70: Pure white; 6" x 2" fruits; flavorful, mild flesh; compact plant |
| Eggplant | Listada di Gandia OG | 80: Lilac w/ white stripe; teardrop fruit; tender & delicious |
| Eggplant | Pingtung Long OG | 65-75: Dark lavender; tender/sweet; slender & up to 12" long |
| Eggplant | Patio Baby F1 Hybrid | 50: Great container variety! Many 3" fruits on compact plant. Spineless. |
| Eggplant | Rosa Bianca OG | 75: Bulbous & lightly lobed rosy lavender w/ cream shading; never bitter |
| Eggplant | Thai Long Green OG | 70-80: Mild eggplant w/ apple green color, tender, 12" long; a staff favorite! |
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| Melon | Charentais OG | 85: 2-3 lb. grey-green skin, salmon-orange flesh; sweet, very fragrant |
| Melon | Emerald Gem OG | 70-90: Green, striped skin w/ exquisitely flavorful, pale orange flesh; 2-3lbs |
| Cantaloupe | Hales Best Jumbo | 85: Full-sized, fine-textured, delicious, bright orange flesh. Drought tolerant. |
| Cantaloupe | Minnesota Midget OG | 70-100: Early maturing, compact plant; 3 - 4" fruits; good in pots |
| Watermelon | Small Shining Light | 80-90: Early, 10-12" round, sweet red flesh. Well-suited to high altitudes |
| Watermelon | Sugar Baby OG | 75: Early, very sweet, 8" round, 8 lb icebox melon. Drought-resistant |
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| Okra | Carmine Splendor F1 | 51: Early, red, high-yielding variety; sweet/mild. Upright plants, stout pods. |
| Okra | Jing Orange | 60: Rare. Reddish-orange very tender pods are 6-8" and very flavorful. |
| Okra | Alice Elliot OG | 80: Rare heirloom. 4-6" tender green pods. Drought/heat tolerant. WCG seed. |
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| Summer Squash | Black Beauty Zucchini OG | 50: Classic, versatile dark green zucchini squash. Compact bush plants. |
| Summer Squash | Bennings Green Tint Pattypan | 57: Scalloped light green squash; sweet/tender, squash bug-resistant |
| Summer Squash | Lemon | 55: Lemon yellow fruit, compact but prolific; resistant to squash bugs |
| Summer Squash | Sunburst Pattypan (F1 Hybrid) | 50: Bright yellow w/ green blossom ends. Compact & squash bug resistant. |
| Summer Squash | Costata Romanesco OG | 52: Clearly superior texture & flavor to other zucchini. Striped and ribbed. |
| Summer Squash | Zephyr (F1 Hybrid) | 54: Vigorous, high-yielding delicious yellow squash w/ green blossom ends. |
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| Winter Squash | Buttercup - Burgess OG | 95: Turban shaped; dark green; orange flesh tastes like sweet potatoes |
| Winter Squash | Butternut Honey Nut OG | 110: Sweet, single serving size, compact vines, powdery mildew resistant |
| Winter Squash | Waltham Butternut | 100: Customer favorite! Sweet orange flesh, stores up to 6+ mos if properly cured |
| Winter Squash | Bush Delicata | 80: Smooth, nutty flesh; Compact bush habit; Powdery mildew resistant |

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| Pumpkin | Queensland Blue | 110: Blue turban-shaped 10-20 lb. fruit; deeply ribbed; gold flesh; sweet |
| Pumpkin | New England Pie OG | 102: Excellent flavor in a 4-5 lb fruit; a standard, reliable pie pumpkin! |
| Pumpkin | Baby Pam OG | 85: 7-10", Sweet, fine-grained flesh, perfect for pies, stores well |

| Tomato | Anthony Bourdain's Passionate Heart OG** | 72: IND: 1-lb red oxheart w/ bold sweet flavor, excellent acid balance |
| Tomato | Blue Beauty** | 80: IND; 8 oz red slicer w/ blue-black shoulders, high antioxidants. Rare. |
| Tomato | Blush Tiger OG** | 75: IND; Exceptionally sweet, juicy & fruity. Golden yellow plum w/ pink blush. |
