

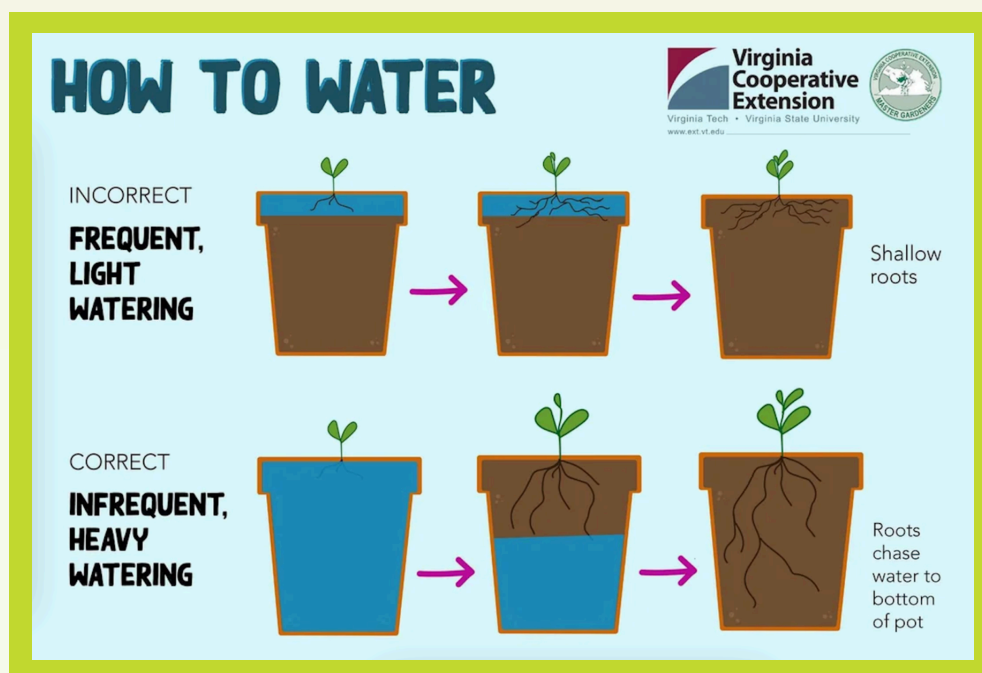


EDIBLE PERENNIALS

An Edible Perennial is a plant that lives more than 2 years and can safely be consumed by humans! We have selected specific varieties of perennials that will not only grow with ease in your garden, but add value to your soil and hopefully your plate.

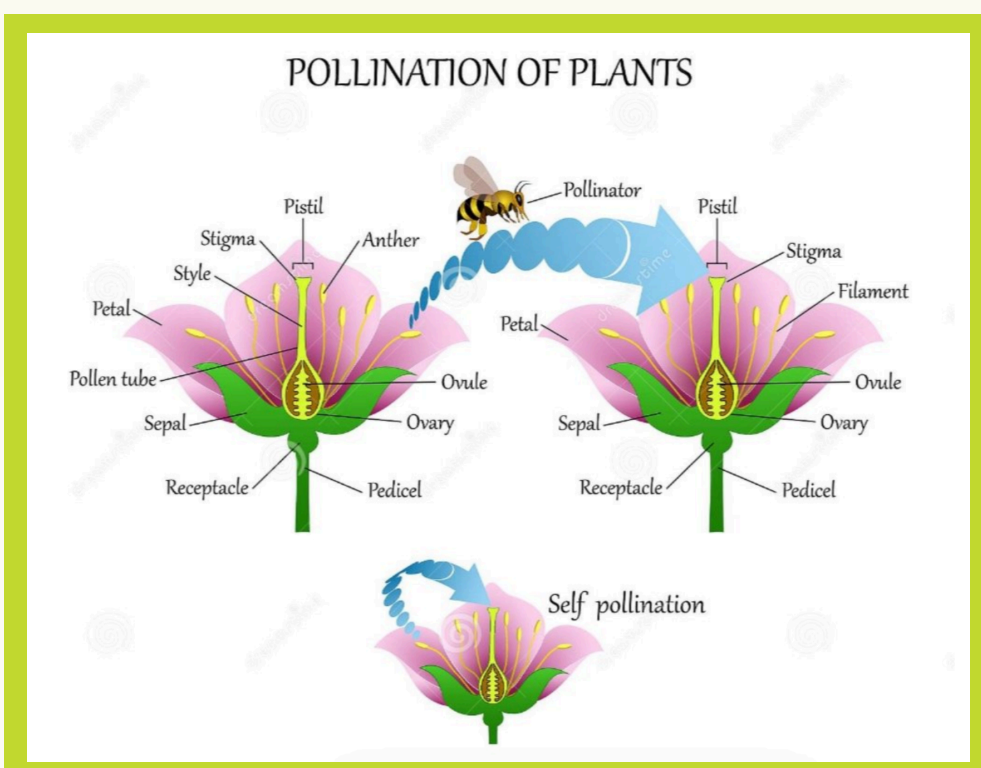
All perennials have been hardened off. They've been watered every 3-4 days to encourage drought tolerance. These plants prefer fewer, deeper watering, so only water if your soil has dried out 4"-6" from the surface.

The estimated maturity size of each perennial is stated on the tag, make sure to plant in a space with plenty of room (and appropriate sun/shade) for your plants.



Some Edible Perennials need Pollenizers

A pollenizer is a plant that provides pollen. Some plants provide their own pollen to fertilize flowers and set fruit. Others need a second plant, a pollinizer, to provide the pollen for reproduction. A pollinizer can be a different variety of the same species. If the variety you would like to purchase states it needs a pollenizer, consider purchasing more than one variety.
