

Enter the Utah State Fairpark at the main entrance off of 1000 W. Inform the parking attendant that you are there for the WCG Spring Plant Sale and they will direct you ahead to Gate B. Parking for the Spring Plant Sale will be FREE.


Drive past the Driver License Division and through Gate B.

Continue driving straight through until you reach the parking lot to the south of the stadium. Look for the big yellow slide. This is where you'll park! Our parking volunteers will direct you to an available spot. We highly recommend carpooling if possible!

After parking your car, walk down the paved pathway at the south end of the parking lot toward the Market and Sheep barns.

Our Spring Plant Sale will be hosted in the Market and Sheep barns! Enter the northeast door of the Market barn to begin shopping. A map of the plant selections will be available soon to help you plan our your shopping experience.

Directly across from the Market and Sheep barns is the Show Ring where bathrooms and drinking fountains are located. This building will also have our Volunteer Headquarters with resources for those of you joining us as volunteers.



Once you've finished shopping the sale, return to your car at the parking lot and exit the lot at the southwest corner of the lot. DO NOT exit the same way you entered the parking lot.

There will be two lanes of exit traffic behind the Market and Sheep barns. The left lane of traffic will be for picking up compost and if you've used our Veggie Valet service. The right lane of traffic will be for thru traffic exiting the sale.

Once you've picked up your compost and your Veggie Valet plants, exit the Fairpark at Gate 9 onto North Temple.

If you're coming to the Spring Plant Sale via public transit, you can take TRAX to the Fairpark Station at 1150 W. North Temple, just south of the Fairpark.

Walk to the west end of the TRAX station and cross North Temple at the crosswalk.

Enter the Spring Plant Sale through Gate 9. We will have an entrance for foot traffic sectioned off.
